This is Mr Young's third performance of Introspection in five months and said it was an honour to be working with Mr Griffiths.

"It's my great pleasure and honour to be collaborating with Alan Griffiths this year in bringing Introspection to life through live performance," he said.

"This unique cycle of piano works is immediately engaging, thoughtful and profound."

Mr Young is no stranger to Shepparton, winning second prize in the town's Australia National Piano Award in 2012.

Since then he has gone on to have a successful career, winning Australia's two most prestigious piano scholarships; the 2016 Allison/Henderson Sydney Eisteddfod Scholarship, and the 2016 Michael Kieran Harvey Piano Scholarship.

Mr Young was looking forward to returning to Shepparton

"I'm really looking forward to being able to play some great music in a great venue," he said.

Mr Griffiths composed the piano repertoire for Introspection during a 27-year period, while in between film scoring jobs.

Last year he met Mr Young and together the pair started a working relationship.

"Nicholas is a genius, you put anything in front of him and he just does it," he said.

"He is such a joy to work with because he's completely relaxed."
